

PROTEA RESIDENCE RULES

A student shall be guilty of misconduct if he or she deliberately or through negligence contravenes any of the university or residences rules

- 1. Smokes in residence buildings
- 2. Makes a noise-human, audio or any kind
- 3. Creates conflict in room/flat, corridor
- 4. Parties in room
- 5. Does not maintain kitchen, bathroom or bedroom or any other facility in a good state of tidiness
- 6. Abuse facilities in res. TV areas, laundry, electrical equipment
- 7. Remove furniture from one area to another
- 8. Tampers with notice boards, posters or signs
- 9. Cooks in residence bedroom
- 10. Uses a stove as a heater
- 11. Possessed a pet
- 12. Gives keys, codes or student Cards to another not from residences
- 13. Possesses inflammable substances
- 14. Uses illegal and unsafe electrical appliances
- 15. Irons in places not deemed for ironing
- 16. Starts a fire in a non-designated area
- 17. Makes a false report on fire and maintenance issues
- 18. Discharges fireworks
- 19. Uses candles
- 20. Misuses, tampers with or damages fire safety equipment
- 21. Uses, possesses or distributes liquor in cans, bottles or glass bottles in a University residence without the necessary approval
- 22. Undermines and disrespects authority
- 23. Uses fire escape doors when there is not a threatening emergency
- 24. Displays any other behaviour that infringes the university residences rules for students or conflicts with the normal and the peaceful co-existence in the residences
- 25. Sublet the residence room to another student or person (the unlawful arrangement whereby a registered student of a room assigns his/her privileges to another student in return for rent
- 26. Allows squatting (squatting is allowing illegal occupation and use of University residences and related facilities without the necessary authority)
- 27. Allows cohabitation to occur (cohabitation is the unauthorised living with a partner in a university residence
- 28. Contravenes visiting hours i. e 10am Friday to Sunday 12am. (Wednesday last day for issuing Visitors Permits)
